Public Officials

- Elected officials serve on boards in this capacity only while they are in office.
- If a public official designates a representative to serve in his/her place, that person (and not the public official) is the board member.

Private Sector

- Should be officials or members of business, industry, and labor, religious, welfare, education, law enforcement, or other major groups and interest in the community served.

Low Income

- Must be democratically selected to assure that they are representative of low- income people in the service area
- If chosen to represent a particular neighborhood, the must reside there
- Should represent current low-income residents, but don't need to be low-income themselves.

Board array of democratic selection techniques:

- Election by ballot at community meeting
- Elected or designed from elected leaders of low-income groups

Basic Responsibilities of a Board Member

- Ensure Effective Organization Planning
- Ensure Adequate Resources= Fundraising
- Set and review the organization's mission philosophy and goals
- Evaluate the organization's program and operations on a regular basis
- Oversee the development of the agency's budget and monitor its execution
- Representative of some aspect of segment of the population in the community
- A willingness to advance the mission of the board and agency
- A willingness to contribute 6 to 10 hr/month for meetings etc.
